September 24, 2018

1. Call to Order at 7:03 pm and announce a quorum was present.
2. Invocation was given by Mayor Eric Hunter
3. Pledge of Allegiance to the American and Texas Flag

4. Mayor's Announcements
Mayor Hunter said the low-cost rabies shots will be November 17th from 10 am to noon. The next planning meeting for the Fall Festival will be October 9th at 3:45 pm. The Fall Festival will be on October 27th. There will also be a firework show.
5. Action Items
 - A. Discussion and act on proposed Ordinance 2018-21, adopting an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019.
Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Basham to go into Executive Session at 7:08 pm Authorized by Texas Government Code Section 551.074 — Personnel Matters. Motion was seconded by Councilman Harris, motion carried 5-0.
Motion was made by Councilman Trammell to reconvene in Open Session at 7:20 pm. Motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Basham. motion carried 5-0.
Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Basham to adopt Ordinance 2018-21 the annual operating budget for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30: 2019 and amend that budget by adopting the salary step chart of the Police Department sheet I - chart 2 — adopt that and it will remain in effect from January 1st of 2019 and have it remained in effect through the entire year of 2019.
Motion was seconded by Councilman Trammell Motion carried with Roll ("All vote: Mayor Pro Tem Basham, Councilman Harris, Councilwoman Jenkins Councilman Trammell. and Councilman Patterson all voting for.

- B. Discussion and act on proposed Resolution 2018-9-24-18-09R ratifying the municipal budget for 2018-2019.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Basham to approve Resolution 2018-9-24-18-09R of the City of Reno, Texas, Ratifying the Municipal Budget for Fiscal Year 20182019 which raises more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year. Motion was seconded by Councilman Harris. Motion carried with a Roll Call vote: Mayor Pro Tem Basham, Councilman Harris, Councilwoman Jenkins, Councilman Trammell, and Councilman Patterson all voting for.

- C. Discussion and act on proposed Ordinance 2018-22, levying ad valorem (Property) tax rate for the year 2018/2019 in the amount of \$0.520000 per \$100.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Basham to adopt Ordinance 2018-22 that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a maintenance and operations tax rate or \$0.4138 per One Hundred Dollars (\$ 100.00) of assessed valuation, which is effectively a 2.6 percent increase in the tax rate and adoption of a debt tax rate \$0.101 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00 of assessed valuation. Motion was seconded Councilman Trammell. Motion carried with a Roll Call vote: Mayor Pro Tem Basham Councilman Harris Councilwoman Jenkins Councilman Trammell and Councilman Patterson all voting for.

- D. Discussion and act on proposed Ordinance 2018-28 continuing the Municipal Court Technology Fund.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Basham to adopt Ordinance 2018-28, continuing the Municipal Court Technology Fund. Motion was seconded by Councilman Trammell motion carried 5-0.
