You are receiving this notice because, according to the Parker County Appraisal District's property tax rolls, your organization provides a service within the area proposed for voluntary annexation into the City of Reno, Texas.

LEGAL NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN under the provisions of Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code that the City of Reno will hold the first public hearings during the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on June 17, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. (Public Hearing # 1) and the second public hearing will be held July 15, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. (Public Hearing # 2), located at 195 W. Reno Road, Azle, Texas 76020, for the purpose of receiving public comments on the proposed initiation of voluntary annexation proceedings of the following property located in Parker County, Texas, totaling approximately 51,742 acres, also known as the Creek Forest annexation.

1. 51.742 acres of land out of the R.H. Matthews Survey, Abstract No. 879 and the T. & P. R.R. Co. Survey, Section No. 1, Abstract No. 1371, Parker County, Texas.

The annexation petition, including a map, is available for inspection at Reno City Hall, 195 W. Reno Road, Azle, Texas 76020, Texas between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. A Municipal Services Plan for the tract will be available at the public hearing and copies will be available for inspection. After the two (2) required public hearings, the City Council will consider an ordinance for the annexation at their July 15, 2019 City Council meeting.
